It is a fantastic way to review so many different aspects of learning such as tenses, vocabulary, questions and of course, numbers. It's also a great way to engage all learners and it works well at every level.

I find the activity works best with learners working in pairs or trios using slightly different Bingo cards – this really enhances the element of competition and therefore the learners' focus!

To avoid any mistakes being made (or any cheating!), I always ask my learners to also number the words / phrases they cover so that we can do a thorough check afterwards and pick up on any discrepancies.
